





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Epsilon Energy Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Epsilon Energy Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points. The greatest weakness of Epsilon Energy Ltd is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 120%, being 35% points above the market average of 85%.
