



The relative strengths and weaknesses of New Concept Energy Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of New Concept Energy Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points. The greatest weakness of New Concept Energy Inc is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 121%, being 24% points above the market average of 97%.
