

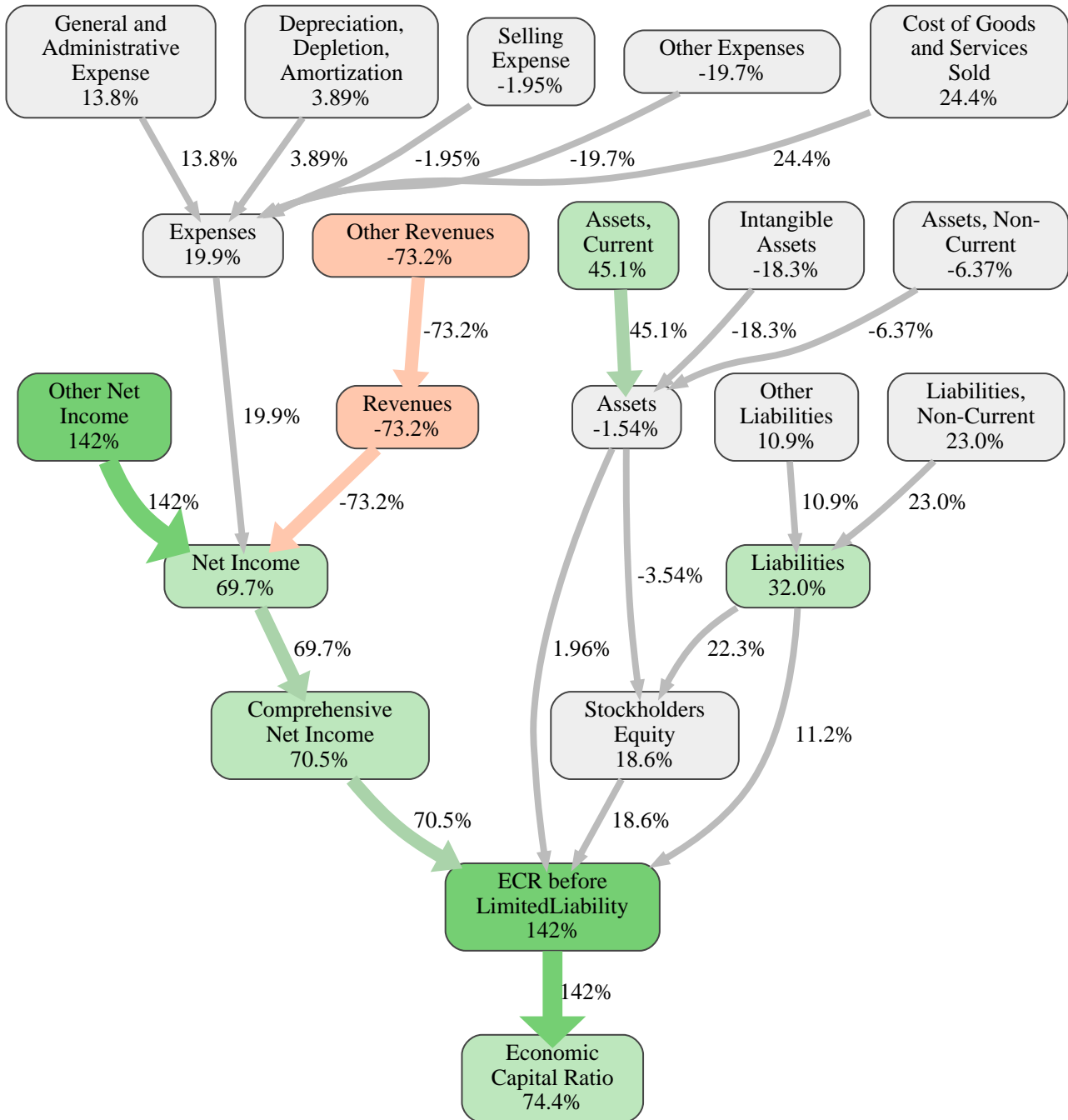

## Shutterstock Inc Rank 13 of 49



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Shutterstock Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Shutterstock Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 142% points. The greatest weakness of Shutterstock Inc is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 73% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 298%, being 74% points above the market average of 223%.
