



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Shutterstock Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Shutterstock Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 80% points. The greatest weakness of Shutterstock Inc is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 279%, being 78% points above the market average of 201%.
