



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Liveramp Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Liveramp Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 139% points. The greatest weakness of Liveramp Holdings Inc is the variable Research and Development Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 10% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 334%, being 150% points above the market average of 184%.
