



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Onfolio Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Onfolio Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 115% points. The greatest weakness of Onfolio Holdings Inc is the variable Selling Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 270%, being 86% points above the market average of 184%.
