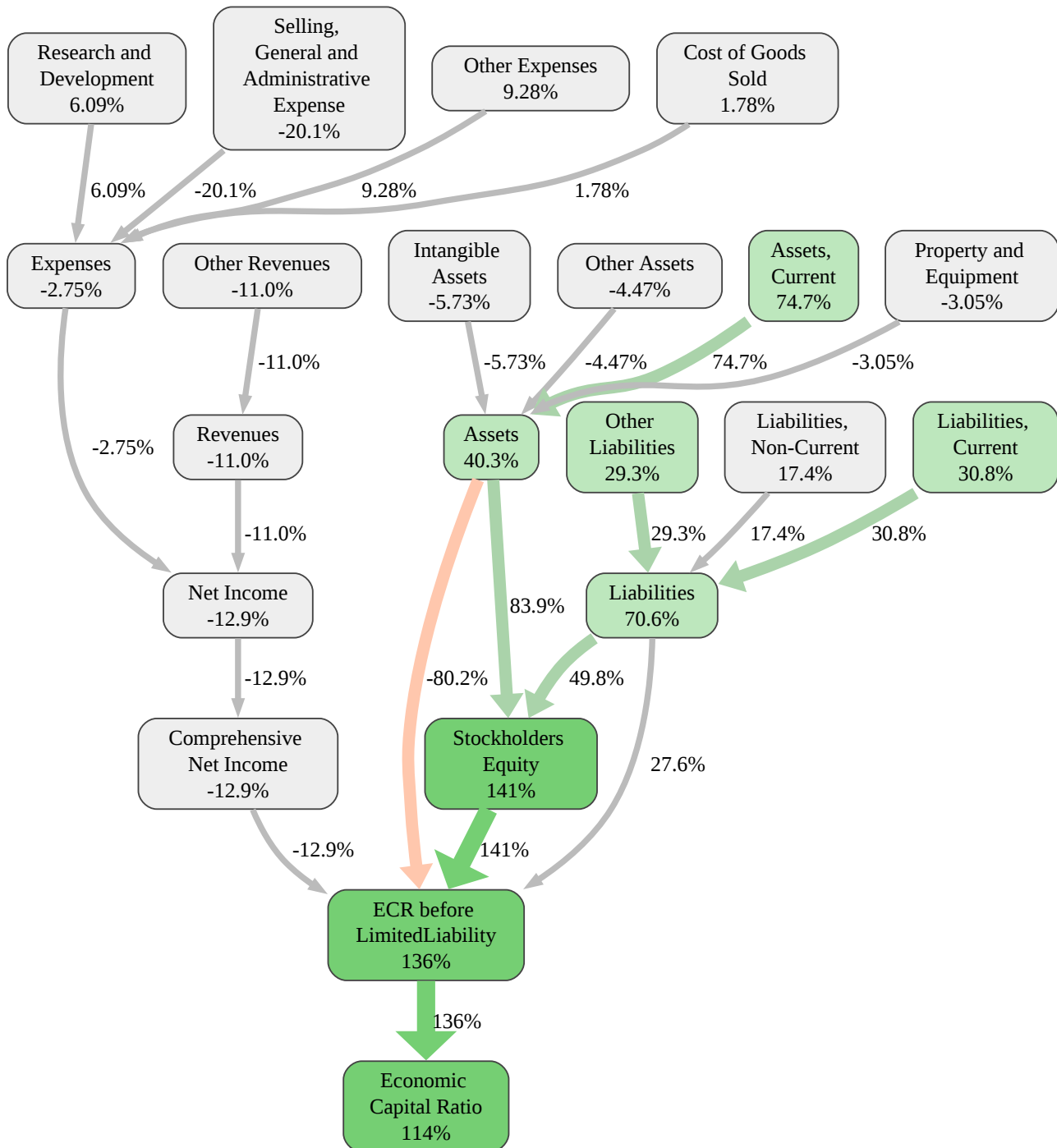




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 141% points. The greatest weakness of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 358%, being 114% points above the market average of 245%.
