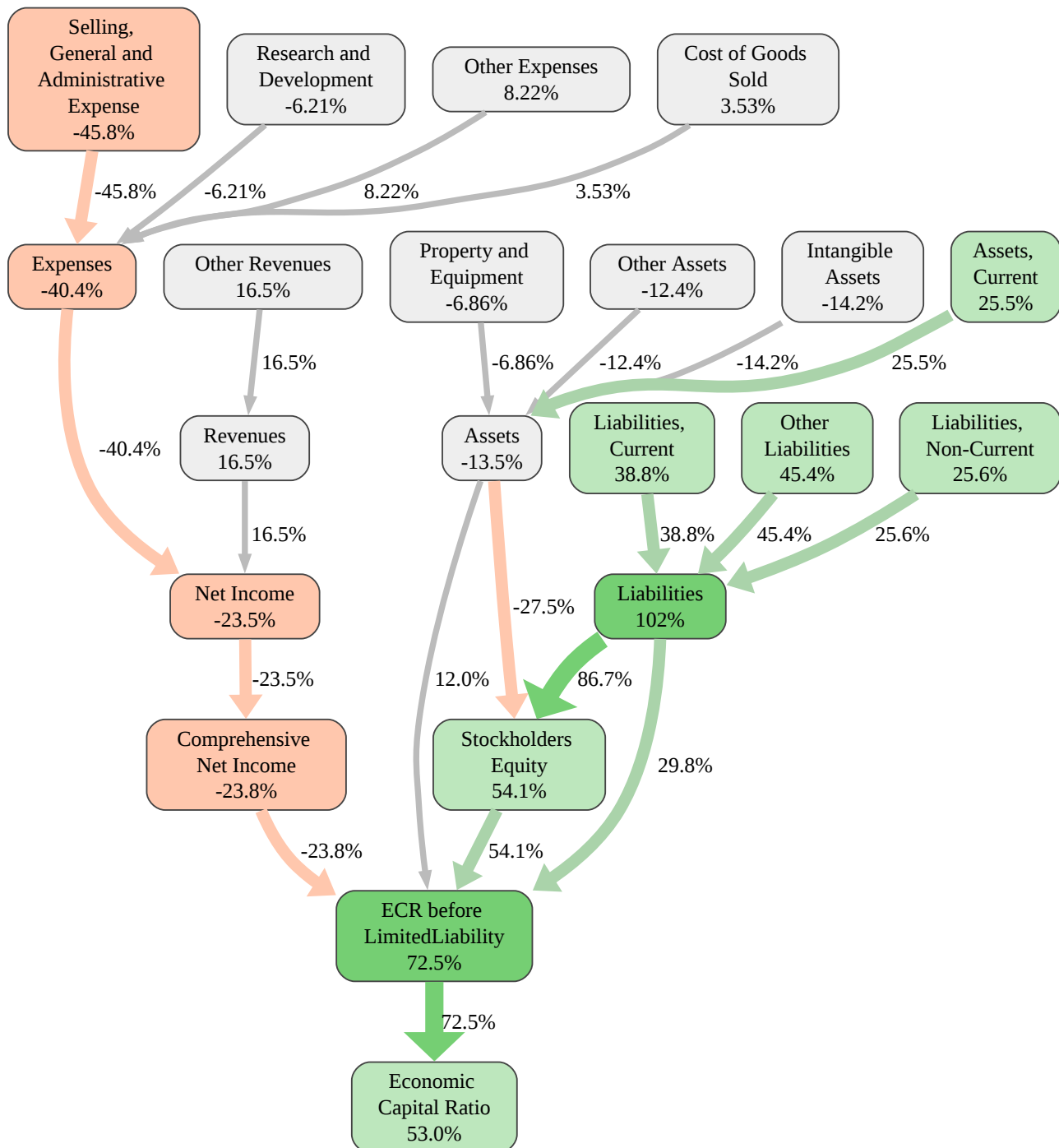




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 102% points. The greatest weakness of Acadia Pharmaceuticals INC is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 46% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 305%, being 53% points above the market average of 252%.
