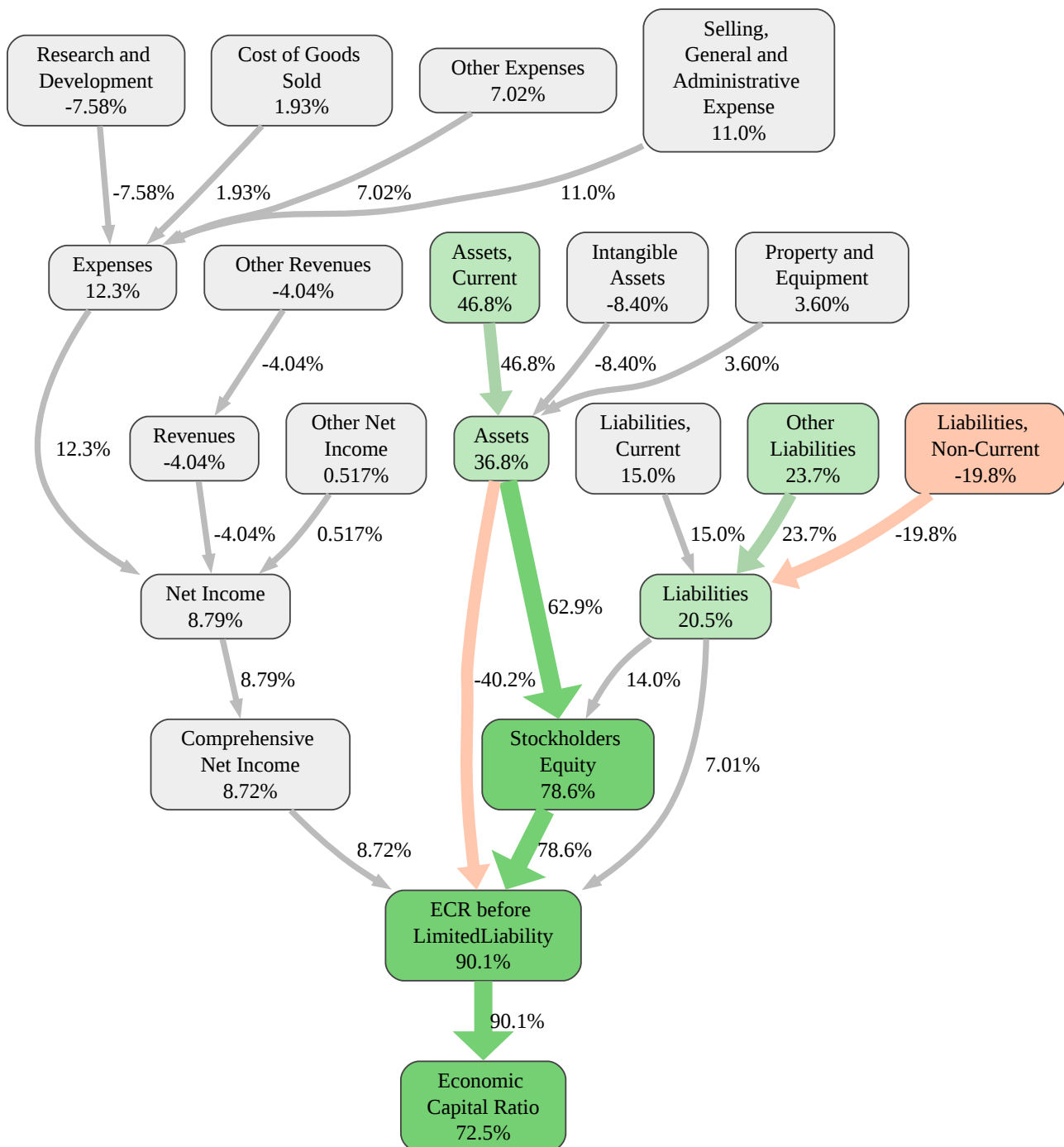




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Beone Medicines Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Beone Medicines Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points. The greatest weakness of Beone Medicines Ltd is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 322%, being 72% points above the market average of 250%.
