



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Groupon Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Groupon Inc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 159% points. The greatest weakness of Groupon Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 95% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 101%, being 159% points above the market average of -58%.
