The relative strengths and weaknesses of Nasdaq INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Nasdaq INC compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of Nasdaq INC is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 69% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 42%, being 58% points below the market average of 100%.
