



The relative strengths and weaknesses of MI Select Futures I Lp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of MI Select Futures I Lp compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points. The greatest weakness of MI Select Futures I Lp is the variable General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 10% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 221%, being 71% points above the market average of 150%.
