



The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Oil Fund Lp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Oil Fund Lp compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 190% points. The greatest weakness of United States Oil Fund Lp is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 91% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 137%, being 5.1% points below the market average of 142%.
