





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Renewable Energy Group Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Renewable Energy Group Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 757% points. The greatest weakness of Renewable Energy Group Inc. is the variable Cost of Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 808% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 450%, being 553% points above the market average of -103%.
