Echelon CORP Rank 29 of 40





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Echelon CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Echelon CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 165% points. The greatest weakness of Echelon CORP is the variable Costs of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 322% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 175%, being 40% points below the market average of 215%.
