

COMPUTERS 2013

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of HP INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of HP INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 163% points. The greatest weakness of HP INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 709% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 166%, being 43% points below the market average of 209%.
