Xerox CORP Rank 18 of 40



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Xerox CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Xerox CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 151% points. The greatest weakness of Xerox CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 321% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 225%, being 16% points above the market average of 209%.
