



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Aegion Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Aegion Corp compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Non-current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points. The greatest weakness of Aegion Corp is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 58% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 91%, being 30% points above the market average of 61%.
