



The relative strengths and weaknesses of IMS Health Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of IMS Health Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 92% points. The greatest weakness of IMS Health Holdings Inc is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 32%, being 39% points above the market average of -6.9%.
