Goodrx Holdings Inc Rank 25 of 55









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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Goodrx Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Goodrx Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 68% points. The greatest weakness of Goodrx Holdings Inc is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 72% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 50%, being 80% points above the market average of -30%.
