







The relative strengths and weaknesses of Yext Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Yext Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points. The greatest weakness of Yext Inc is the variable Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 30%, being 88% points above the market average of -58%.
