



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Netspend Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Netspend Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 197% points. The greatest weakness of Netspend Holdings Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 359% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 196%, being 65% points above the market average of 131%.
