



The relative strengths and weaknesses of KKR Financial Holdings LLC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of KKR Financial Holdings LLC compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 191% points. The greatest weakness of KKR Financial Holdings LLC is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 191% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 68%, being 30% points below the market average of 98%.
