



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Invesco Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Invesco Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Investments, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 86% points. The greatest weakness of Invesco Ltd is the variable Deposits and Payables to Customers, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 96% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 63%, being 78% points above the market average of -15%.
