



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Ccur Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Ccur Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points. The greatest weakness of Ccur Holdings Inc is the variable Selling and General Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 346%, being 368% points above the market average of -22%.
