



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Apollo Asset Management Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Apollo Asset Management Inc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of Apollo Asset Management Inc is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 45% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 85%, being 12% points above the market average of 73%.
