



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Mondelez International Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Mondelez International Inc compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 69% points. The greatest weakness of Mondelez International Inc is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 83%, being 19% points above the market average of 64%.
