Chemed CORP Rank 8 of 17









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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Chemed CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Chemed CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 146% points. The greatest weakness of Chemed CORP is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 128% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 228%, being 2.1% points below the market average of 230%.
