



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Genesis Healthcare Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Genesis Healthcare Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of Genesis Healthcare Inc is the variable Long Term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 188% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 1.7%, being 60% points below the market average of 62%.
