



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Rennova Health Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Rennova Health Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 251% points. The greatest weakness of Rennova Health Inc is the variable General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 456%, being 317% points above the market average of 139%.
