



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Foundation Medicine Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Foundation Medicine Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 155% points. The greatest weakness of Foundation Medicine Inc is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 332%, being 203% points above the market average of 129%.
