



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Radnet Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Radnet Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 78% points. The greatest weakness of Radnet Inc is the variable Long Term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 246% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 19%, being 79% points below the market average of 97%.
