



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Chemed CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Chemed CORP compared to the market average is the variable Long Term Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 107% points. The greatest weakness of Chemed CORP is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 99% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 287%, being 157% points above the market average of 130%.
