



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Exagen INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Exagen INC compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 163% points. The greatest weakness of Exagen INC is the variable Long Term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 87% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 173%, being 44% points above the market average of 130%.
