



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Natera Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Natera Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 131% points. The greatest weakness of Natera Inc is the variable Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 66% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 147%, being 39% points below the market average of 186%.
