



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Rennova Health Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Rennova Health Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 98% points. The greatest weakness of Rennova Health Inc is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 434% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -240%, being 328% points below the market average of 89%.
