



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Oncology Institute Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Oncology Institute Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 99% points. The greatest weakness of Oncology Institute Inc is the variable Operating Costs and Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 157% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 171%, being 83% points above the market average of 89%.
