











The relative strengths and weaknesses of Extended Stay America Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Extended Stay America Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of Extended Stay America Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 47%, being 15% points below the market average of 62%.
