







Belmond Ltd Rank 13 of 30



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Belmond Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Belmond Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 148% points. The greatest weakness of Belmond Ltd is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 89% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 55%, being 7.8% points above the market average of 47%.
