



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Caesars Holdings INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Caesars Holdings INC compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Caesars Holdings INC is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -25%, being 203% points above the market average of -228%.
