The relative strengths and weaknesses of Hilton Worldwide Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Hilton Worldwide Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Non-Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of Hilton Worldwide Holdings Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 135% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 32%, being 45% points below the market average of 77%.
