Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. Rank 29 of 51









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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 306% points. The greatest weakness of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 215% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 125%, being 254% points above the market average of -129%.
