The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 297% points. The greatest weakness of Cooper-Standard Holdings Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 347% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -9.3%, being 18% points below the market average of 8.6%.
