LCI INDUSTRIES Rank 20 of 66







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The relative strengths and weaknesses of LCI INDUSTRIES are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LCI INDUSTRIES compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 513% points. The greatest weakness of LCI INDUSTRIES is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 429% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 148%, being 194% points above the market average of -46%.
