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The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Financial Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Financial Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of American Financial Group Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 71% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 18%, being 35% points below the market average of 53%.
