



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sooner Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sooner Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 73% points. The greatest weakness of Sooner Holdings Inc is the variable Other Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 161%, being 70% points above the market average of 91%.
