



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Emerald Oil Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Emerald Oil Inc compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 80% points. The greatest weakness of Emerald Oil Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 28% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 133%, being 41% points above the market average of 91%.
