



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Laredo Oil Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Laredo Oil Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 517% points. The greatest weakness of Laredo Oil Inc is the variable Oil and Gas Property, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 125% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -298%, being 389% points below the market average of 91%.
