#### Warren Resources INC Rank 75 of 191

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Warren Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Warren Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 58% points. The greatest weakness of Warren Resources INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 62% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 90%, being 40% points above the market average of 50%.
