The relative strengths and weaknesses of Whiting Holdings LLC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Whiting Holdings LLC compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 89% points. The greatest weakness of Whiting Holdings LLC is the variable Oil and Gas Property, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 31% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 77%, being 27% points above the market average of 50%.
